Why does a proper worldview matter?

Our worldview determines our behavior and what we deem acceptable as good and true. It deems what we trust in, follow and support.

- 2. Me-ism Phil. 2:1-5
- 3. Hedonism 1 Cor. 6:12-20
- 4. Pluralism John 14:6
- 5. Naturalism Hebrews 11:6
- 6. Humanism Eph. 2:1-10

A Biblical world view answers four questions

1. Where did I come from?

I am created by God - Genesis 1:27

He alone has the power to give life

As a result, all life matters to Him

2. What is my purpose?

I was created with and for a purpose

Eph. 2:10

3. Why is the world so messed up?

Sin came into the world because of disobedience and stained the blood stream for all humanity. Romans 3:23

4. Is there any hope?

Our Hope is in Jesus Christ. Romans 5:1-2
